Re: COVID-19 Update

In an effort safely reopen the state and avoid a resurgence in cases, RI Governor Gina Raimondo signed an executive order requiring face masks in public places effective Friday, May 8, 2020. The order will apply in all public areas, both indoor and outdoor, where there is a chance of coming within 6 feet of another person. Masks don't have to be specially made; scarfs or bandannas will provide the same protection as long as the nose and mouth are covered.

The only exceptions include young children and anyone whose health would be negatively impacted by wearing a face covering.
